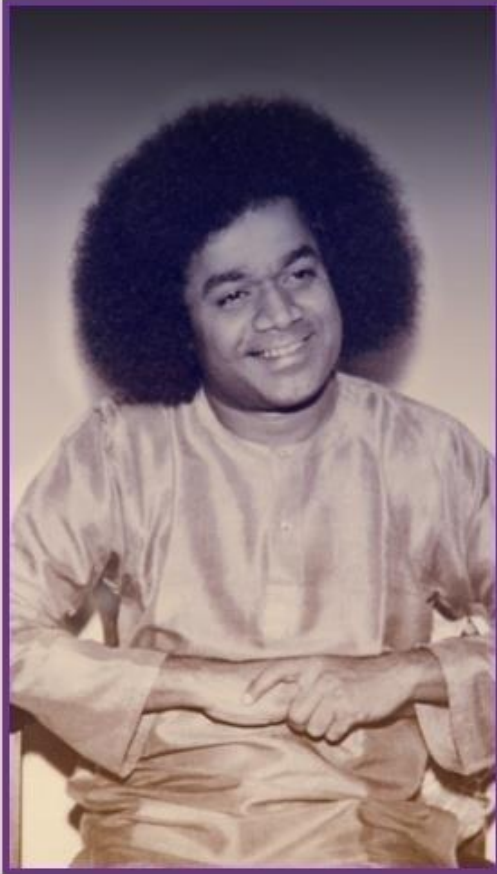

Students showcased their talent and presented a speech on the importance of Republic Day that filled the air in respect, love, unity and strength that binds the nation together."

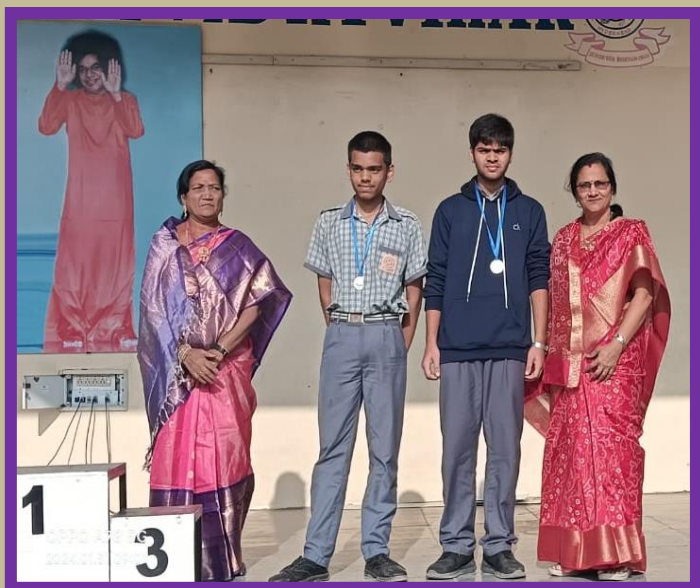


## ANNUAL SPORTS
