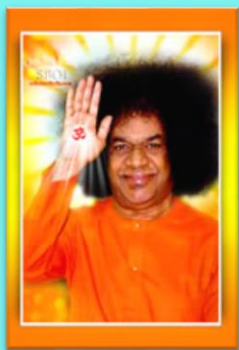

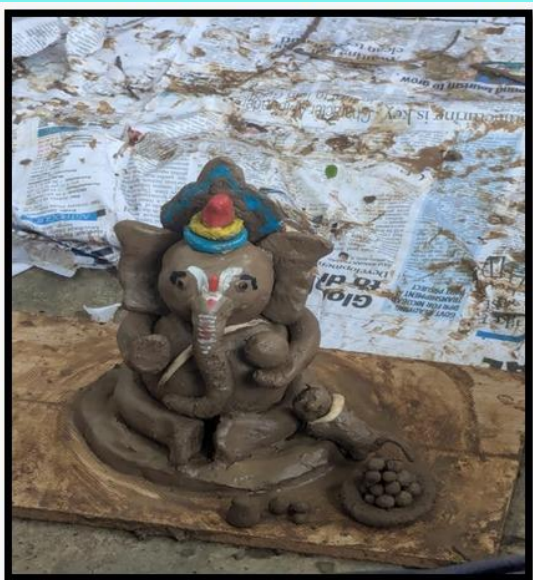

YOGA

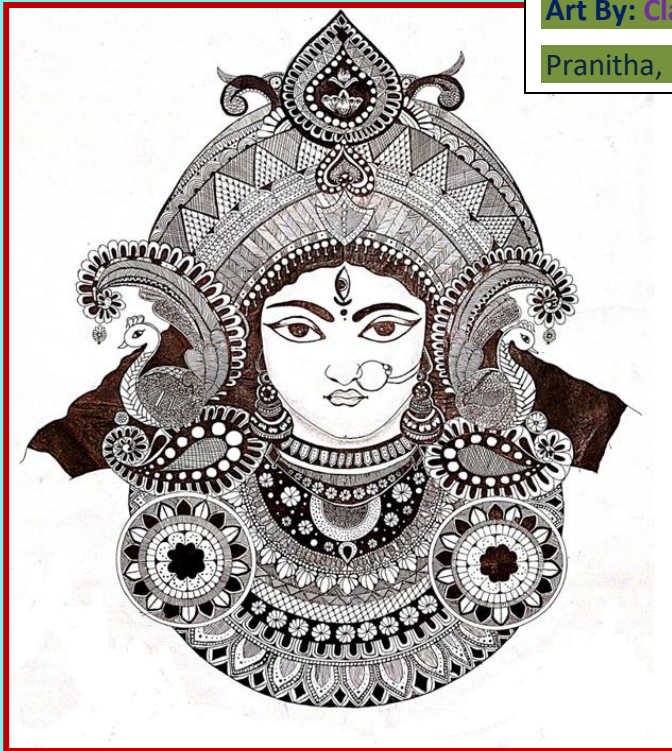

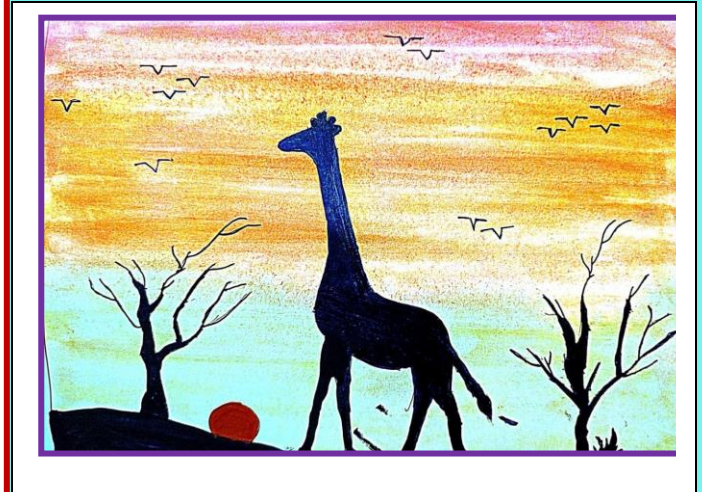
