- Speak softly with love and care.

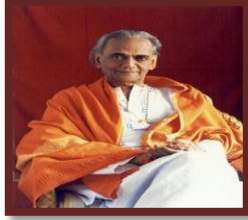

He practiced under the guidance of his brother Dr.Satyanarayana. He learnt various schools of Indian dance like Bharath Natyam , Kathak, Kathakali and Manipuri from different gurus. He acquired scholarly knowledge in theoretical aspects of Indian Dances and studied their origin, history and development which helped him to write and publish books. He worked as a visiting professor in the Central university of Hyderabad. Ramakrishna's efforts to consolidate his work and perpetuate the Andhra Traditions of dance like Lasya aspect of 'Andhra Natyam' and Tandava aspect of Perini to the succeeding generations are noteworthy.

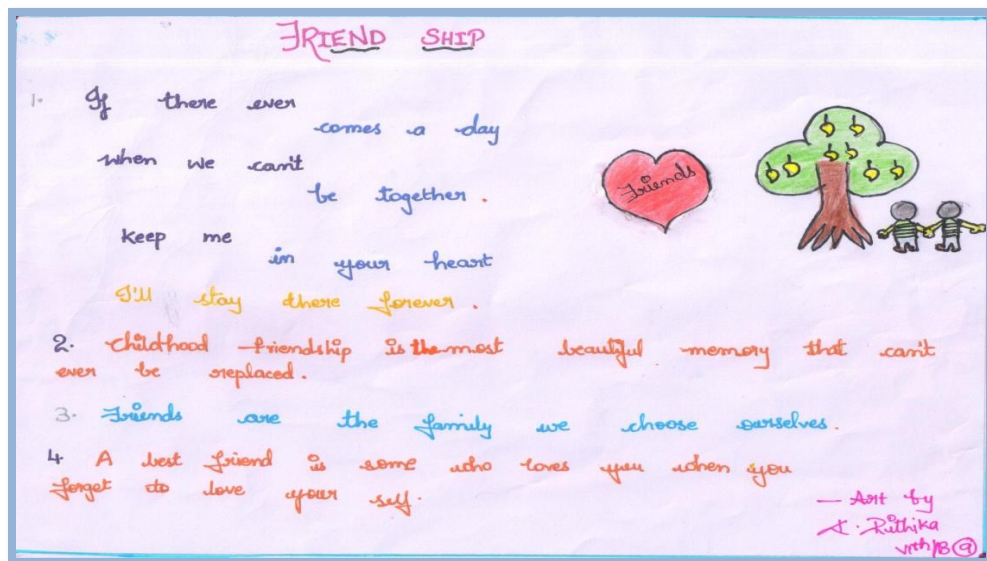

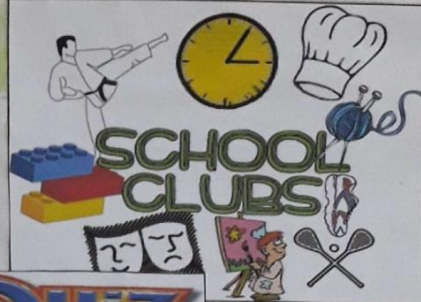

QUIZ CLUB

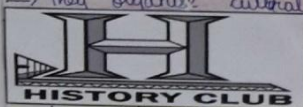
→ We will know more about General Knowledge. This will help to foster a desire for knowledge. They will conduct some quiz competitions.
