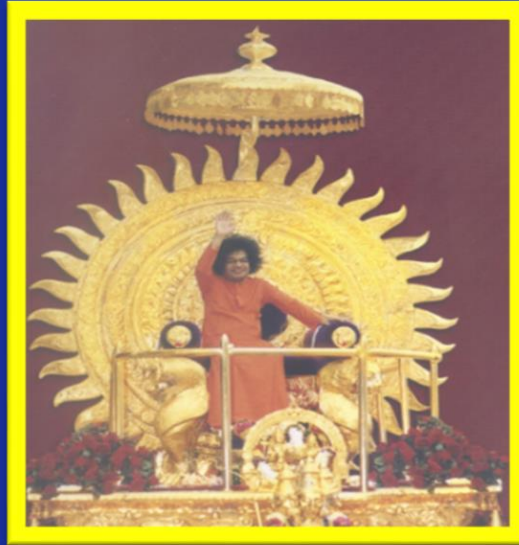

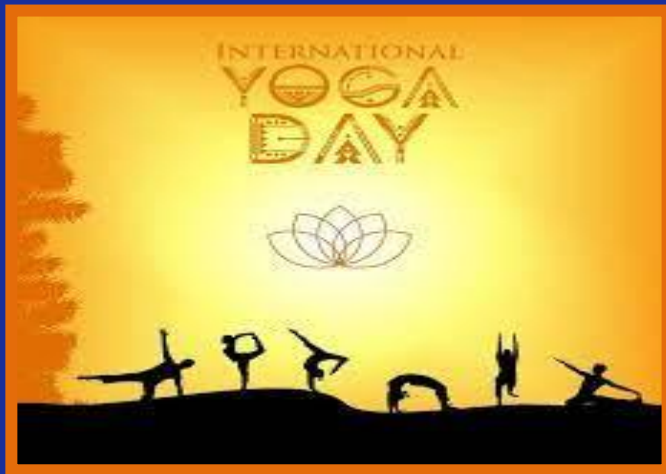

"The End of Education is Character".

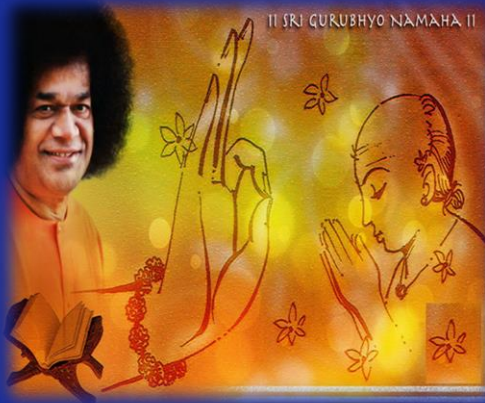
INTERNATIONAL YOGA DAY - 21ST JUNE

SPORTS - ACHIEVEMENTS

Kum. Sidhabatula Rathnika is the National player in the sport of Cycling. In spite of her hectic schedule she secured 9.8 in Class-X (2022-23). Parents expressed their gratitude to the School Management for accommodating her presence due to erratic timings while practice sessions as well as during participation in tournaments.



- She started her career in 2019. Till date she has received 23 medals in different categories in Cycling.
- On 24th and 25th of September 2022, she has secured 1st place in three different events in state road cycling championship held at Karimnagar, Telangana.
- She has participated in National Championships held at Guwahati, Assam from 11th December to 15th December 2022 and secured place in the Top 10.
- She has won 2 Silver and 2 Bronze medals in Khelo India Women's Cycling League (South Zone) held at SATS Cycling Velodrome, Hyderabad from 13th March to 16th March 2022.
- Considering all the best performances in her career, Cycling Federation of India (CFI) and Khelo India Committee have selected her for the National Camp in Thiruvananthapuram, Kerala for the training to represent India in Olympics.
She is the first female to be selected from Telangana for Cycling National Camp.

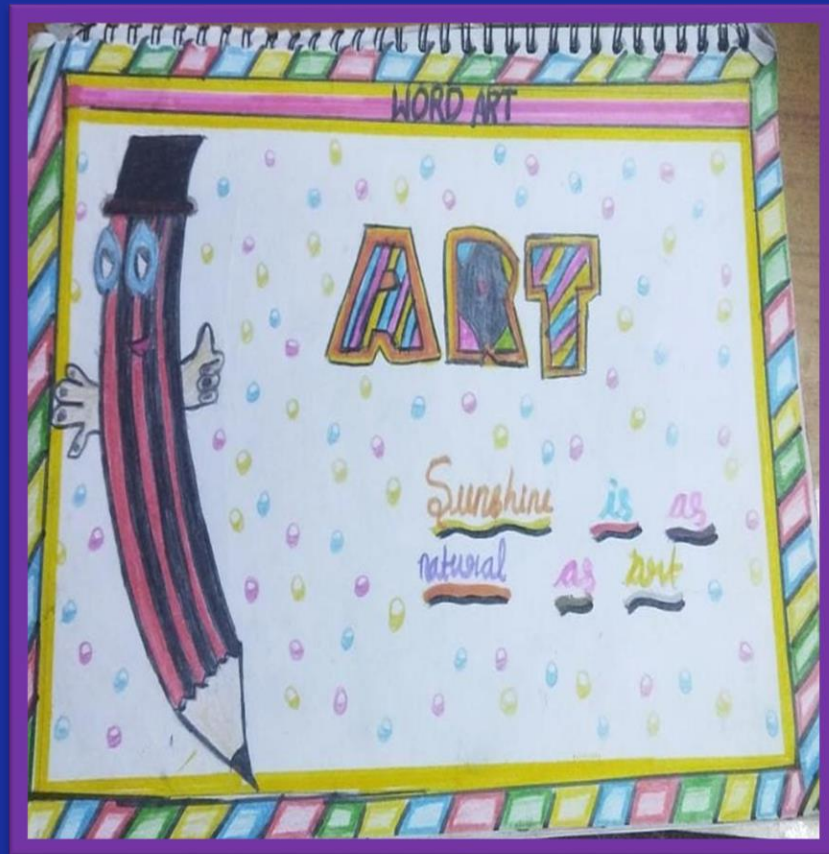
