






SHIVAM PROGRAM





CRICKET

Cricket is a bat and ball game played between two teams of 11 players on a field at the centre of which is 22 yards Pitch with 3 wickets at each end, each comprising two bails balanced on three stumps. The batting side scores runs by striking the ball bowled at the wicket with the bat, while bowling and fielding side tries to prevent this and dismiss each player. The batsman is declared out when the ball hits the stumps and dislodges the bails or the ball is caught after it was hit by bat before it touches the ground by the fielding side.


FRIENDSHIP

M. SHASHI PRANAI (V-B) qualified for State Level Roller Hockey skating held on 15th November 2019 secured Gold medal and has been selected for National.




M. LOKESHWAR (X-A) secured 3rd place in State Level U17 Football Tournament organized by School Games Federation held at Warangal, Torruru.




R. HARSHITH RAJ (VI-A) secured Bronze medal in District Level Skating held at Indira Park on 4th September 2019.
